### SECTIONS

The heading of a section should be in capital Arial 9-point bold and all text in Times New Roman 10-point. Sections should not be numbered.

### FIGURES AND TABLES

You can place figures and tables at the top or bottom of the appropriate column or columns, or in the middle of the text on the same page as the relevant text (please see the following examples).

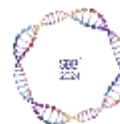
Captions should be numbered (e.g., “Table 1” or “Figure 2”). Please note that the words “Figure” and “Table” should be spelled out.

**Please, use a minimum of 1 and maximum of 2 graphical elements (01 figure and 01 table, or 2 figures or 2 tables).**
